

## Does anyone in your household have symptoms of coronavirus?

If yes, telephone the school to discuss.

Do **NOT** attend school.

Seek a Covid test by:

1. Going online

2. Or by phoning 119.

**PLEASE tell us of the outcome of the test as soon as possible.**

### Positive Test Result:

Public Health England (PHE) will use Track and Trace to instruct anyone who had contact with your child to self isolate. If more than one case is confirmed in the school, PHE may advise we close part or all of the school for 14 days for a deep clean. Learning for ALL children (including critical workers) will continue online.

### Negative Test Result:

Telephone us to arrange a return to school for your whole household.

## KEY COVID SYMPTOMS



**A high temperature** – this is when your skin feels very hot when you touch it, especially the skin on your chest or your back



**A persistent new cough** – this means coughing a lot when you didn't have a cough before. These coughing bursts happen 3 or 4 times in 24 hours

## Other symptoms

- shortness of breath
- Loss of sense of taste or smell that is noticeable different to your normal senses



## ILLNESS AT SCHOOL

Any child developing Covid symptoms in the day will be isolated in the PPA Room and sent home. Please seek a test and keep at home for 7 days.

Siblings to be kept home for 14 or until a negative test result is returned.

## REMEMBER!
